



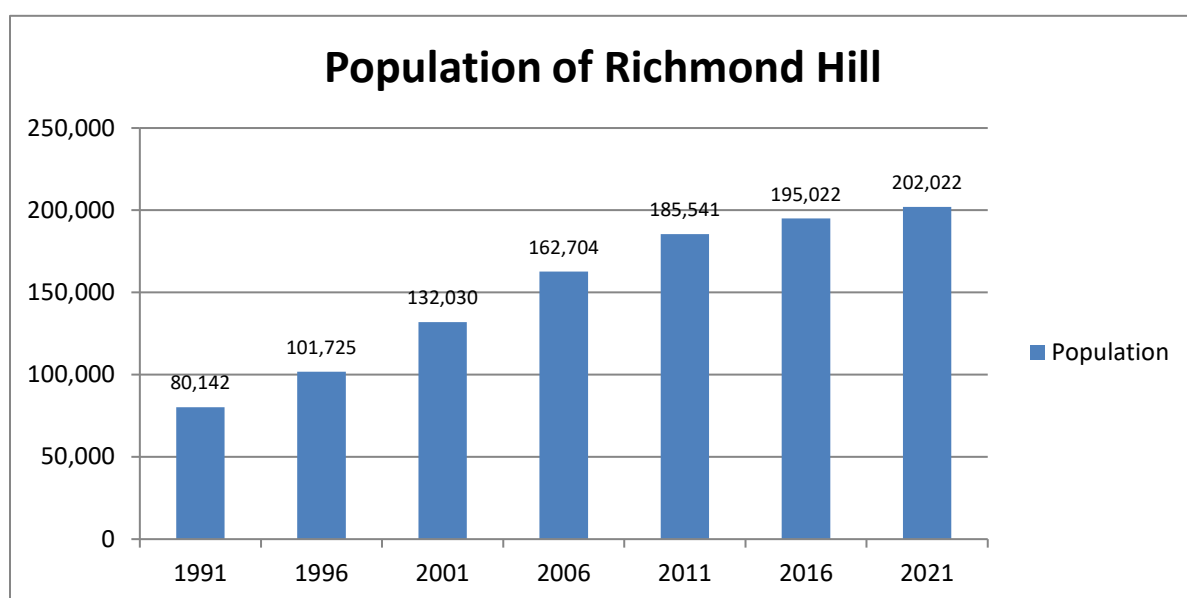
2021 Census Profile on the City of Richmond Hill

Release #1: Population and dwelling counts

Population

- Richmond Hill's population was counted as 202,022, as of May 11, 2021.
- The population of Richmond Hill increased by 7,000 people between 2016 and 2021. This is a rate of increase of 3.6%.
- The number of residential dwellings in Richmond Hill also increased, by 5,552 new dwellings between 2016 and 2021.

Comparisons with other jurisdictions

- Richmond Hill continues to see an increase in its population. However, the rate of increase from 2016 to 2021 is lower than the rates for York Region, the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area (CMA), Ontario and Canada.
- As shown on the graph below, the rate of population increase in the 2016 to 2021 period is less than the rate for the 2011 to 2016 period, as is the case for York Region, Toronto (CMA), however not for Ontario or Canada.
