What is the Census?

Every five years, Statistics Canada conducts a Census providing a detailed account of the Canadian population. The Census is intended to provide snapshot of the demographic, social and economic conditions at a precise moment in time.

Why is it important?

characteristics, population density, dwelling types, ethnic origin, mother tongue, immigration trends, education, employment rates, occupation types and income distribution.

















Richmond Hill Residents by Mother Tongue (Single Responses), 2006







Ward 6 Population by Ethnic Origin, 2006










